ITEM-7: APPROVAL FOR MOOC COURSES ASSESSMENT THOROUGH NPTEL - CREDIT TRANSFER - AMENDMENTS

The amendments to MOOC courses assessment thorough NPTEL are placed before the Academic Council for consideration and approval. The details are enclosed.

• Examination and Evaluation for Normalization of Marks for MOOC courses through NPTEL

- Evaluation pattern followed under B.Tech R20A academic regulation is 30:70 (CIE:SEE). Scores secured by the student in MOOCs (25:75) shall be converted to 30: 70 evaluation pattern for equivalency and the letter grades shall be awarded as defined in the B.Tech R20A academic regulation.
- Evaluation pattern followed under B.Tech R22 academic regulation is 40:60 (CIE:SEE). Scores secured by the student in MOOCs (25:75) shall be converted to 40: 60 evaluation pattern for equivalency and the letter grades shall be awarded as defined in the B.Tech R22 academic regulation.

• Reflection of Open Elective Grading in the Marks Memo

The students admitted under R20A and R22 regulations, who opt for open electives 3, 4, & 5, as well as open electives 2, 3, & 4 through MOOC NPTEL, complete the courses during the respective semesters as per the regulations. However, the grades for these courses shall be included in the marks memo wherever the courses are offered physically i.e., in IV year II semester marks memo.

ITEM-10: APPROVAL FOR DISPOSING OF ANSWER SCRIPTS OF THE PASSED OUT BATCHES PERTAINING TO AY'S: 2014-15, 2015-16 AND 2016-17.

It is proposed to dispose of the corrected answer sheets of UG and PG, Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) and Semester End examinations (SEE) pertaining to 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17 academic years through e-waste management. The Institution shall not be held responsible for any claim/ appeal regarding any piece(s) of information contained in any of the destroyed or disposed documents after specified time frame.

The members approved the same.

ITEM-11: APPROVAL FOR ONE-TIME CHANCE FOR THE PG STUDENTS OF R14, R15 AND R18 REGULATIONS TO COMPLETE THE COURSE

It is proposed to conduct Special Supplementary examinations for the candidates who are admitted into M.Tech and MBA in R14, R15 and R18 regulations, to clear backlog courses so as to secure the required credits / to satisfy the academic requirement to get their degree. This last chance is for the candidates who have completed their class work (double the duration of the course).

The members approved and suggested to represent the same to the JNTUH university and seek suggestion from them.

ITEM-12: ANY OTHER POINT WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR

The credits allocated for minor project of II B. Tech for all Undergraduate Programs in Engineering is 1.5 in R20 Regulations. But, 2 credits were allocated for minor project in CSE (AIML) program instead of 1.5 credits in R20 regulations. It is requested to change the credits as 1.5 for minor project of II B. Tech CSE (AIML) in order to maintain the uniformity among all Undergraduate Programs.

The members approved the same.

The credits allocated for 'workshop' laboratory course of I B. Tech for all Undergraduate Programs in Engineering is 1.5 in R20A Regulations. But, 2 credits were allocated for workshop in CSE and AIDS programs instead of 1.5 credits in R20A regulations. It is requested to change the credits as 1.5 for workshop of I B. Tech CSE and AIDS in order to maintain the uniformity among all the branches of the UG Program.

The members approved the same.

AS per the R20 and R20A regulations the number of credits to be obtained to award B. Tech degree under lateral entry scheme is 121. 5. The curriculum of the CSBS program was designed in collaboration with Tata Consultancy Service (TCS). As per the CSBS curriculum, the number of credits to be obtained to award B. Tech degree in CSB program under lateral entry scheme is 120.

The members approved the same.

The AICTE sanctioned M.Tech in VLSI Design from the AY: 2007-08 with F.No. 730-50-249(I)/ET/97 dated 16-07-2007. It is requested to approve the change in the current title of "M.Tech - VLSI System Design" to "M.Tech - VLSI Design" offered by Electronics and Communication Engineering Department. The course code for "M.Tech - VLSI System Design" and "M.Tech - VLSI Design" is the same i.e., 57 as per the JNTUH.

The members approved the same.

The chairman proposed that the institution will be going ahead with hybrid mode of valuation process.

The members approved the same.

Dr. Manzoor Hussain., created awareness on industry readiness. Sri. K. Narendra, suggested to add more syllabus related to industries. Sri. Udaya Kumar Dintyala, suggested to conduct interdisciplinary value discovery workshops.

The chairman of the College Academic Council thanked all the honorable members for attending the meeting, giving valuable inputs and approving the discussion agenda points.
