ITEM-1: CONFIRMATION OF APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF THE EARLIER ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 22.10.2020.

All the Honorable members of the Academic Council confirmed the approval of minutes of the earlier meeting held on 22.10.2020.

ITEM-2: APPRAISING THE RECENT DEVELOPMENTS OF THE INSTITUTION:

Dr. K. Lakshmi Prasad, Chairman of College Academic Council presented and appraised the recent developments of the Institution in terms of Placements, subscription for Courses on Coursera, NASSCOM Future skills, Eduskills, IEEE SWEBOK, and R&D activities.

The honorable members of the Academic Council appreciated the same.

TEM-3: ACADEMIC CALENDARS OF B.TECH, M.TECH, AND MBA:

Dr. K. Lakshmi Prasad presented the revised academic calendars of B.Tech, M.Tech, and MBA.

The revised academic calendars of B.Tech, M.Tech, and MBA were placed before the Academic Council for consideration and approval. The honorable members of the Academic Council approved the same.

ITEM-4: B.TECH EXTERNAL PROJECT WORK EVALUATION:

B.Tech external project work evaluation (Viva-Voce) scheduled between 12th and 20th June 2021 shall be conducted through online mode.

Dr K. Lakshmi Prasad explained that 704 students out of the total 1233 students have cleared aready all the courses except project work. The request for approval of declaration of results, issue of grade sheets and PCs to these students, once they clear the Project work is presented to the honorable members of CAC.

The proposal was placed before the academic council for consideration and approval. The honorable members of the Academic Council approved the same. Honorable members also approved declaration of results and issue of PCs and grade sheets to those students who have cleared all the courses and Project work.

ITEM-5: CONDUCT OF B.TECH FINAL YEAR (EIGHTH SEMESTER) END SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS:

B.Tech. Final year (Eighth semester) end semester examinations scheduled in June 2021 shall be conducted through online mode in June 2021. The duration and question paper pattern shall be of the regular pattern as per the regulations.

The proposal was placed before the academic council for consideration and approval. The honorable members felt that the pandemic is already in recession and there is every possibility to start the academic processes after June 15, 2021. Hence, as the number of days required to conduct the examinations are only

vo/three days, they suggested planning of the exams offline after 20th June, 2021. The results can be declared within a week for those students who attended for the semester end examinations. The decision to conduct the semester end examinations online may be postponed for the time being. In case the pandemic continues, and there is no scope for conduct of examinations offline, the CAC members authorized the Principal of the Institution to take the decision to conduct the semester end examinations online and seek the permission of JNTUH.

ITEM-6: CONDUCT OF THE SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATIONS FOR B. TECH FINAL YEAR STUDENTS:

The supplementary examinations for the B. Tech final year students shall be conducted rough online mode in June/July 2021.

The proposal was placed before the academic council for consideration and approval. The honorable members suggested conducting the supplementary examinations in offline mode after the regular examinations. In case the pandemic continues, and there is no scope for conduct of examinations offline, the CAC members authorized the Principal of the Institution to take the decision to conduct the semester end examinations online and seek the permission of JNTUH.

ITEM-7: M.TECH AND MBA EXTERNAL PROJECT WORK EVALUATION:

M.Tech and MBA external project work evaluation (Viva-Voce) scheduled in July 2021 shall be conducted through online mode. The proposal was placed before the academic council for consideration and approval. The honorable members of the Academic Council approved the same.

ITEM-8: CONDUCT OF MBA FINAL SEMESTER (IV SEMESTER) END EXAMINATIONS AND THE SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATIONS FOR MBA AND M.TECH FINAL YEAR:

MBA final semester (IV semester) end examinations and the supplementary examinations for MBA and M.Tech final year shall be conducted through online mode in June/ July 2021.

The proposal was placed before the academic council for consideration and approval. The honorable members felt that the pandemic is already in recession and there is every possibility to start the academic processes after June 15, 2021. They recommended conducting the examinations offline. The decision to conduct the semester end examinations online may be postponed for the time being. In case the pandemic continues, and there is no scope for conduct of examinations offline, the CAC members authorized the Principal of the Institution to take the decision to conduct the semester end examinations online and seek the permission of JNTUH.

ITEM-9: ANY OTHER POINT WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR

The honorable members enquired proactive initiatives, if any during these uncertain times like vaccination for students appearing for examinations, in case conducted physically. Dr. K. Lakshmi Prasad appraised all the initiatives, precautions, measures, financial help, vaccination and facilities created by the Management for the wellbeing of the students, staff and their family members during these uncertain times.
