The admission will be made in accordance with Regulations notified by the AICTE (GSR 4761E) dated 20.05.1994 based on the Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgment dated 04.02.1993 with regard to WP(C) No. 607 of 1992 in the case of Unni Krishnan JP and other vs. State Government of Andhra Pradesh and others etc. and later judgements. No Management/Institute/Trust or Society shall announce admissions directly under any circumstances. Any action contrary to this provision of the institute will make it liable to be derecognised.

Further in the event of infringement/contravention or non-compliance of the norms and standards as prescribed by the AICTE, the Council shall take further action to withdraw approval, and the liability arising out of such withdrawal of approval shall be solely that of Management/Trust/Society and/of Institution.

The Council may inspect/ visit the Institution any time it may deem fit to note the progress/ compliance.

The attention of the management is drawn to the fact that the approval given now is only for one academic session, at the end of which an expert committee shall visit to assess if the norms and standards as stipulated by AICTE are fulfilled, and only then will the continuation or otherwise shall be intimated.

You are requested to closely monitor the progress made by these institutions and keep the concerned Regional Office and AICTE, New Delhi informed.
